



## Dr. Armand Balboni

Dr. Armand Balboni is an infectious disease expert and a Commissioned Officer in the U.S. Army with 17 years of military service. He currently serves as the CEO of Appili Therapeutics, an infectious disease biotech with an active COVID-19 program. Prior to this role, he was an assistant professor at West Point Military Academy.

While in the U.S. Army, Dr. Balboni's experience included serving as the Deputy Director, Office of Regulated Activities (ORA) in the U.S. Army Medical Materiel Development Activity (USAMMDA). He also worked in U.S. Army Research Institute of Infectious Diseases (USAMRIID) during the department's work to curtail the Ebola Zaire outbreak. He completed a U.S. Department of Defense fellowship at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's Center for Drug Evaluation and Research (CDER) in the Division of Anti-infective Products, and in the Office of Counterterrorism and Emerging Threats (OCET).

Dr. Balboni completed his doctoral work in the MD/PhD program at Mount Sinai and earned his law degree at Brooklyn Law School. He currently lives outside of Washington, D.C. with his family.
